## Will I keep coming to the hospital for treatment?

Yes, a lot of your treatment will stay the same.

Your doctor will tell you and your parents if there are any changes.

## Will things be different in the hospital?

**Yes**, things will be a bit different for a while.

**Clothes:** A lot of people you meet will be wearing different clothes, like gloves, masks and special goggles.

**Space:** Everyone has been asked to stand apart. We call this keeping our social distance. It means that there will be more space between chairs and people walking around the hospital.

**Attendance:** Not everyone can come with you to your treatment during this time, but you will be able to call them whenever you want.

## What can I do to help?

**Wash** your hands after sneezing, coughing, and blowing your nose, after you use the toilet, and before you eat.

**Catch** your coughs and sneezes in your elbow.

**Wear** your mask and gloves when your parents or the doctors and nurses ask you to.

**Stand apart** to make sure that everyone has enough space.

Remember that all the doctors and nurses and everyone working at the hospital are still here to look after you.
